## Program Summary

We offer two streams of CMSA (Calgary Minor Soccer Association) competitive soccer at the U7-18 levels.

- **“CMSA Basic Program”** offers players games and weekly coach-led practices.
- **“CMSA Academy Team Program”** offers players interested in competing in higher Tiers with like-minded and like-skilled players the opportunity to join a program which provides additional technical training led by our professional staff, in addition to games and weekly coach-led practices.

Prices for the two streams listed in the following program information are inclusive of all costs. There are NO HIDDEN FEES (including volunteer and uniform deposits which have been charged in the past). Tier 1 players only will be offered an additional training package. These fees will only be charged after team placement.

### SWU ACADEMY TEAM PROGRAM INFORMATION

- ✓ Academy training for Tier 1 teams will run year-round, except during long weekends and the scheduled holiday breaks in August and December.
- ✓ Placement on a U11-U17 Academy Team guarantees pre-season placement on a Tier 1-3 team. Players who are placed on an Academy Team that is relegated to Tier 4 following the Pre-season will remain in the Academy Team Program. No refunds will be granted to players wishing to withdraw from the Academy Team Program following the club's CMSA registration closing date of September 26.
- ✓ **U11-U17 Tier 1 team placement requires players to pay an additional fee of \$350 for our SWU SAQ program.** This will be applied only after pre-season games are finished and final roster placements have been determined.



## **U7 - U8 CMSA (2011-2010) \$370**

- ✓ Games to be played on Saturdays (Boys); Sunday (Girls) at the Calgary Soccer Centre (CSC), the Calgary West Soccer Centre (CSWC) or the Genesis Centre
- ✓ Teams will be grouped based on geographic location where possible
- ✓ Teams practice and training session can take place any day of the week
- ✓ Mandatory SWU Academy Technical training
- ✓ Season runs from October 28, 2017 to February 24, 2018
- ✓ All teams will play their last league game as a part of the U7/U8 mini-fest on Feb 24, 2018
- ✓ Where possible, requests to play with friends will be fulfilled

## **U9 - U10 CMSA ACADEMY TEAM PROGRAM (2009-2008) \$715**

- ✓ U9/U10 Tier A & B will play Futsal

## **U11 - U12 CMSA ACADEMY TEAM PROGRAM (2007-2006) \$1025**

- ✓ U11/U12 Tier 2-4 will play Boarded soccer and games may be on any day of the week
- ✓ All players MUST attend evaluations
- ✓ Players placed on an Academy Team will begin the pre-season in Tier 1-3. Team placement following pre-season will be dependent upon team performance
- ✓ Teams practice and training session can take place on any day of the week
- ✓ Season Runs from late October to late February early March depending on Tier
- ✓ Post Season Play: Tier 1 Futsal Final Four on March 5 – 8, Tier 1-4 Provincials on March 16 – 18, 2018
- ✓ Tier 1 team placement requires players to pay an additional fee of \$350 for our SWU SAQ program. This will be applied after pre-season games are finished. Tier 1 players will be scheduled for one additional training session per week

## **U12 CMSA BASIC PROGRAM (2007-2006) \$575**

- ✓ U12 Tier 3-6 will play Boarded soccer

- ✓ U12 Tier 6 will play on Saturdays and Mondays
- ✓ All players MUST attend evaluations
- ✓ Players registered in the Basic program will begin the pre-season in Tier 4-6. Team placement following pre-season will be dependent upon team performance
- ✓ Teams practice and training sessions can take place any day of the week
- ✓ Season Runs from late October to late February early March depending on Tier
- ✓ Post Season Play: Tier 6 Indoor City Finals on March 2 – 4, Tier 5 Inter-Cities on March 10 & 11, Tier 3-4 Provincials on March 16 – 18, 2018



## **U13 - U17 CMSA ACADEMY TEAM PROGRAM (2005-2001) \$1070**

- ✓ U13 Tier 1 will play Futsal and games may be played any day of the week
- ✓ U14-U17 Tier 1 will play Boarded soccer and games may be played any day of the week
- ✓ U13-U17 Tier 2-4 will play Boarded soccer and games may be played any day of the week
- ✓ All players MUST attend evaluations
- ✓ Players placed on an Academy Team will begin the pre-season in Tier 1-3. Team placement following pre-season will be dependent upon team performance
- ✓ Teams practice and training sessions can take place any day of the week
- ✓ Season Runs from late October to late February early March depending on Tier
- ✓ Tier 1 soccer is the player's top priority over other sports and activities. Participation in elite National and International tournaments may be required along with Fundraising
- ✓ Post Season Play: Tier 1 U13 Futsal Final Four on March 5 – 8, Tier 1-4 Provincials on March 16 – 18, 2018
- ✓ **Tier 1 team placement requires players to pay an additional fee of \$350 for our SWU SAQ program.** This will be applied after pre-season games are finished. Tier 1 players will be scheduled for one additional training session per week

## **U14 - U18 CMSA BASIC PROGRAM (2005-2000) \$620**

- ✓ U14-U18 Tier 3-6 will play Boarded soccer
- ✓ U18 Tiers 1-2 will play Boarded soccer
- ✓ U14 Tiers 3-4 will play on any day of the week
- ✓ U14 Tier 5 will play on Sundays and Tuesdays
- ✓ U14 Tier 6 will play on Saturdays and Thursdays
- ✓ U16-U18 all Tiers will play on any day of the week
- ✓ All players MUST attend evaluations
- ✓ Players registered in the U14-U16 Basic program will begin the pre-season in Tier 4-6. Team placement following pre-season will be dependent upon team performance.
- ✓ Players registered in the U18 Basic program may be placed in any Tier
- ✓ Teams practice and training sessions can take place any day of the week
