## **POLICY - AFFILIATIONS POLICY**

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The Club shall be a member of the Calgary Minor Soccer Association (CMSA) and its governing bodies: Alberta Soccer Association (ASA), Canada Soccer (CS), and F.I.F.A., and shall ensure compliance with all rules, policies and procedures established by these associations.

The President or designate and accredited representatives shall be the chief delegate at all regional meetings. The President may also attend meetings outside the Calgary Minor Soccer Association should the need arise.

The Board of Directors of the Calgary South West United Soccer Club must give approval to the content of proposed Calgary Minor Soccer Association resolutions. All resolutions shall be forwarded to the Secretary of CSWU.

The Calgary South West United Soccer Club may propose candidates for regional office and may submit resolutions to the Calgary Minor Soccer Association. The CSWU votes shall be cast in accordance with the direction given by the Board of Directors of the Club.

Any member of the Calgary South West United Soccer Club may propose candidates for regional office. The CSWU Board of Directors shall approve any nomination before it is submitted to the Calgary Minor Soccer Association. Submissions to the CMSA must be received 14 days prior to their AGM.

Members of the club wishing to become a candidate for Regional Office must declare their intentions to do so at a meeting of the CSWU Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall approve only candidates for Regional Office who meet the requirements for Regional Office as set out in the CMSA Constitution.
